Welcome to a new exciting school year. Mrs Dewick will be teaching Monday to Wednesday and Mrs Mitchell will finish the week. Here are a few bits of important information:

- To keep your child happy and healthy in school please send them with: black plimsolls to wear indoors to help keep our school nice and clean., a water bottle to aid concentration and a coat as the weather can change quickly.
- Children in Year 2 receive spelling homework. Please look inside your child's spelling book for the weekly word lists. Spelling quizzes will be completed on a Friday. Times tables homework will be sent home in the near future we will begin more formal tests after half term (we will practise at school first).
- In Year 2 we do forest school on a half termly basis. Forest school starts after October on a Thursday afternoon. Please ensure your child has their Forest school kit (lots of warm layers, waterproof coat and trousers, hat, scarf, gloves, socks and wellingtons) in school each week. Wellingtons can be kept at school on our class welly rack located outside our classroom door.
- We do PE on a Monday and Thursday so please make sure your child's kit (including spare dry socks, a plastic bag and trainers) is ready to use on those days.
- If your child needs an inhaler please make sure you have handed an up to date, labelled one to the teacher and you have completed a medical form. This is for all the children's safety.
- Remember reading! This is a vital skill so please support your child as much as you can. We change reading books as often as needed. Children's Reading Record books should travel to and from school every day please.
