

- Please ensure your child is wearing the correct **uniform** on a daily basis. More information can be found on our school website.

- Children will need suitable **kit for Forest School** including waterproof clothing, long sleeves, long trousers and spare socks please ensure this is all named
- If your child needs an **inhaler** in school, please make sure we have an up to date, labelled one and that you have filled in a medical form.
- **Reading** please support your child as much as you can! We encourage reading at home at least 3 times a week and a comment about what you have read in their reading record. Please ensure **reading books** come to and from school every day in book bags.
- Please return any reading books that were borrowed over the holidays so we can ensure our library is well stocked!
- Maths homework will begin by focusing on basic number facts such as bonds to 10 to aid the children's mental fluency. This is a precursor to learning to recall times tables after Christmas. More information on this to follow.
- Our cloakroom is quite compact. To help us, we'd appreciate it if the children only brought book bags or small bags with them as larger bags don't fit on the pegs alongside coats and PE kits.
- In KS1, children are provided with **fruit** as a snack free of charge. You are more than welcome to pack your child a healthy snack if preferred.
- If you would like your child to have **milk** with their snack at breaktime, this can be ordered through coolmilk.com
