

- Please ensure your child is wearing the correct **uniform** on a daily basis. More information can be found on our school website.

- We encourage children to be outside as much as possible so please ensure they have a named pair of **wellies** which can be kept on our class rack outside the classroom door.

- Reading books will be changed as often as needed.
- Please return any reading books that were borrowed over the holidays so we can ensure our library is well stocked!
- In Year 3, children will continue to learn their times tables and by the end of the year are expected to know their 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10s. Times tables books have already gone home to start practising.
- Swimming for Year 3 will take place in the Summer Term.
